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INTRO/CARD

VIGNETTE: Continuing from the previous chapter, DareDolls and Dusk are captured with automatic restraints during a search of the old, abandoned Magic Factory. Their efforts to undo themselves only entwine them further. Subtle camera tilts and pans obscure just how exactly they keep screwing up. Soon they are also sporting glowing wristbands and leg irons!

We cut back to the CrimeBase Lodge, where Dusk and Sweets sit comfortably, reminiscing not so comfortably about their mishap with the automatic restraints....

DUSK

Wow. That was not our finest hour.

SWEETS

Tell me about it. It was like losing a battle of wits with a vending machine.

DUSK

Let's just move on. I'm embarrassed enough for both of us right now.

SWEETS

Yeah. Let's just take the next viewer question.

Tex from Youngstown wants to know: "Have you ever been roped 'rodeo-style' and are you wearing that lingerie I sent you?"

SWEETS AND DUSK

SWEETS

SWEETS

When I do, I don't go dancing.

DUSK

Fair enough. Fair enough. Next question!

SWEETS

Zagrevo from prtztqjte, Slovakia....

Ad-libbing here, they attempt to pronounce some consonant-heavy name but finally give up. Sweets even hands the card to Dusk so that her partner can try to decipher this strange name, but Dusk is no help and hands it back.

SWEETS

(continuing)

Zagrevo from Someplacewecantpronounce, Slovakia wants to know, "Why your nets are so heavy?"

DUSK

You know, that's a good question. I always thought it was because we were in a Magic Factory.

SWEETS

Yeah, those were definitely magic nets.

DUSK

And here's a magical moment just for our friend in Slovakia, who has beautiful handwriting, by the way.

VIGNETTE: They are caught in a net that defies gravity--why does it keep pulling them down to earth? One would think it weighed 300 pounds....

SWEETS

I'd like to see Jane Fonda try
that workout.

DUSK

Or how about the time we had to
fight our way out of that Body
Wrap trap?

SWEETS

Right. We were nearly defeated by
the heat of our combined bodies,
but thank goodness that floor was
cold.

VIGNETTE: Standing in a pit and dangling from a rope by
their wrists, they are wrapped in plastic. Sweets produces a
small knife from her glove and uses it to cut them loose.
They roll to the floor and continue rolling until their
